## Peer Support Training

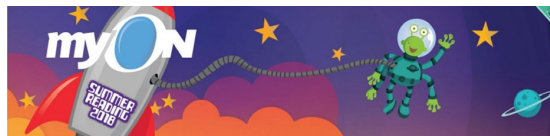
