Breakfast Muffins

Ingredients:

- 6 eggs
- 2-3 cups mixed vegetables (carrot, capsicum, green onion and frozen peas)
- 2 slices of ham
- 2 Tbs milk
- 1/2 cup reduced fat grated cheese
- Pepper to season

Method:

- Preheat oven to 160 degrees and grease a 12 hole muffin tin.
- Cut all vegetables and ham into small pieces.
- Whisk milk and eggs together then add vegetables and ham. Add pepper and mix well.
- Pour mixture into muffin tins and top each muffin with a small amount of cheese.
- Bake in the oven for 25-30 minutes.
- Serve warm or cold.



NOTE: mixed frozen vegetables are great for this recipe. They are often pre-cut so all you need to do is scoop out 2-3 cups.

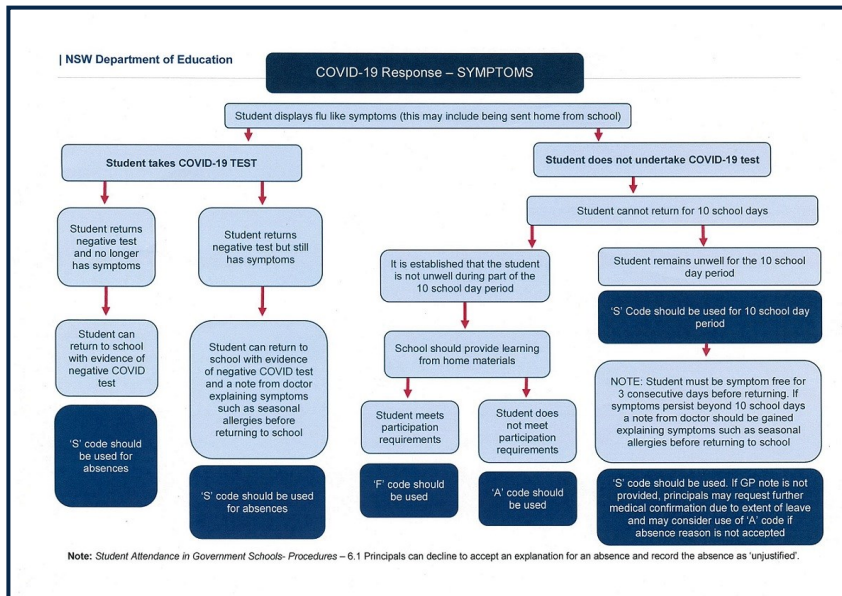
Allow two fingers between your eyebrows and your helmet

1 Gilmore Crescent, Byron Bay.


