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Year 5 OC 2023 Applications

Opportunity classes cater for intellectually gifted and high potential students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates of their own academic standard. These classes help students to learn by grouping them with students of similar ability, using specialised evidence-based teaching methods and materials.

Year 5 enrolments are available at 76 primary schools across NSW including a virtual opportunity class at Aurora College for students in rural and remote areas. Parents apply when their children are in Year 4. Successful students are offered placement, and if the parents accept the offer, the students usually attend the opportunity class full time in Years 5 and 6 at the relevant public school. This is a two-year placement program and there is no provision to apply for Year 6 entry only. In the majority of cases, students who accept a place in an opportunity class will leave their current school to attend the school with the opportunity class.

Information has now been sent home (via email) to all families of Year 4 students. Please read through the information if you are considering applying for Year 5 entry.

Key dates to remember are:

- Application website opens: Tuesday 26 April 2022
- Application website closes: 5pm, Friday 13 May 2022 You must apply before this deadline.

Evans River School Canteen Supervisor

Evans River K – 12 School P & C Association manage and operate the Evans River K - 12 School Canteen five days per week throughout the NSW School Term. We are committed to promoting healthy eating and providing nutritious food at an affordable price for our students and staff with all profits donated back to the school.

Hours for this position are: 5 days per week, with flexibility of 5-7 hours per day depending on demand and requirements for the day. This position is available for commencement from 9th May 2022 with a paid handover to be conducted. Wages are in accordance with the Fast Food Industry Award 2010. Level 3 Casual may be negotiable with relevant experience. The P&C will consider a job share arrangement for this role, provided that we have suitable candidates to undertake the role. To be considered for this position you must meet the following criteria:

Essential Selection Criteria

- Hold a current Food Handling and Preparation Certificate and Paid Working With Children Check.
- Demonstrated capacity to work with a volunteer organisation to deliver high quality nutritious food and facilitate the integration of related school programs.
- Knowledge of good nutrition, experience in food handling and the ability to promote and encourage the sale of nutritious food in accordance with the NSW Department of Education *Nutrition in Schools Policy* and the *NSW Healthy School Canteen Strategy*.
- Proven high level interpersonal skills with proven leadership, time management, organisational and stock management skills and a well-developed capacity to work with volunteers, students and staff.
- Enthusiasm and a genuine interest in supporting the Evans River K-12 School community.

Desirable Selection Criteria

- Previous experience in working in a school canteen.
- Experience in online ordering platforms and use of electronic cash registers.

It is a requirement of employment that a Prohibited Employment Declaration is provided and that potential employee consents to Employment Screening checks.
