Results from the carnival:

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

Next Monday, students from Year 1 to 6 will begin participating in our annual Peer Support program as part of their Personal Development and Health program. The Peer Support program provides a fun and engaging opportunity for students to learn about issues such as bullying, relationships and self-image. Students in Year 6 will lead students from Years 1 to 5 in a series of weekly lessons. This year, the program delivered by the Year 6 students is called Stronger Together - A module focusing on Anti-Bullying. This week students started their training program in preparation for the Peer Support program to begin next week.



#### Len Diett Round 1 & 2

This week the Evans River K-12 Under 13 and Under 15s Rugby Union teams competed in round 1 and 2 of the Len Diett Shield. The Len Diett Shield is a Northern Rivers high school Rugby Union competition with 8 schools currently competing.

On Monday our teams took on Lindisfarne Anglican College at Evans with the U/13s playing first. Judah Heath opened the scoring with a brilliant solo effort to put Evans River ahead. This sparked our Tweed opponents into action with their backline lighting the oval up moving the ball extremely well and scoring some excellent tries. Evans rallied hard and eventually went down 44-10.

In the U/15s it was seesawing battle with Lindisfarne going out to an early lead with some strong forward play, however Evans bounced back with some slick back plays seeing Latrell Gordan scoring a hattrick. In the end Lindisfarne took out the game winning 22-17.

On Wednesday it was round 2 and again we played host, this time to Emmanuel Anglican College. In the 13s, Emmanuel where short players, with Evans River showing excellent sportsmanship lending them players to ensure









they had enough for a game. Evans started slowly with Emmauel dominating early and scoring 3 quick tries. In the second half Evans rallied together with Hayden Graham, Charlie Comerford and Riley Mason having an outstanding game to keep Evans in the contest. Unfortunately, Emmanuel was too strong taking the game 29-12.

In the U/15s Evans started strong with some hard running from Max Ticknor, Luke Stewart, Hunter Sykes and Lachlan Swansborough making metres with ease. This set the platform for our classy backline lead by Cooper Pendrigh to tear Emmanuel apart and set up some amazing team tries. Jordan Koroheke was excellent at lineout time and lead the team around the park with aid from Brad Felsch. In the end most of the game was one way traffic with Evans scoring 7 tries winning 37-0. An outstanding team effort, putting the rest of the competition on notice.

A big thankyou must be made to Mr Walker, who refereed both games on Monday and Wednesday. Mr Burrows who warmed the teams up in his strategic consultancy role also need special mention. Next week our teams take on Woodlawn on Wednesday at Evans River. Best of luck to all involved, no doubt you will proudly represent Evans River K-12.


