#### Far North Coast Regional Surf Titles

Evans River School competed in the Surfing NSW - Far North Coast Regional School Titles on 19<sup>th</sup> of May. Our school entered two teams into the competition with Ned Barany and Lewi Scott in the first team and Max McGillivray and Sol Novak in the other. Our school competed against other schools in the region at Lennox Point with 2-3ft waves, offshore wind and sunny skies. The format of the comp was tag team with 20-minute heats and 3 -4 teams in the water at the same time. In the opening elimination Round, both Evans River teams placed second to Kingscliff and Lindisfarne but this

was enough to progress to the Semi-final round. In the Semi-final Round, both Evans River teams squeaked past elimination and into the finals, again placing second with Ballina Coast High and Xavier looking like the team to beat with both teams posting excellent scores. Coming second in both the opening and semi-final round meant that to win the event we needed to change tactics and pick up our game. With a few tips from Max's dad Mick and a few changes in strategy and improving teamwork, our teams entered the final against Ballina Coast High and Xavier Catholic College. In the first wave of the heat, Xavier Catholic posted a near-perfect 9.6 point ride and looked like they had it in the bag. Sol answered back with a 6.3 and kept one of our teams in the game and tagged Max in. Max quickly backed the score with a 6.7 and one of our teams was now in first. Meanwhile, Lewi and Ned as well as the other teams including Xavier Catholic were struggling to find waves in the deteriorating conditions. With a minute left on the clock the other surfer from Xavier found a wave needing only a 3.4 to place ahead of our team but the wave did not allow for the score and the rider fell. Max and Sol were the comp winners placing ahead of Xavier in second, Ballina Coast in third in and Lewi/Ned fourth place overall. Congratulations to all participants for an amazing day of surfing and big congratulations to Max and Sol who are now off to State Titles! Special thanks also to super-coach dad Mick McGillivray for all the support and tips as well.
