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#### **Sunny crowned Queensland Champion**

Sunny McLean (Year 9) took up boxing 4-5 years ago. He became involved because he wanted to use his time is a positive way. On Saturday night Sunny fought for the Australian Boxing Council's Junior Lightweight Queensland title. He defeated his opponent, who elected not to return for the second round of the bout. Sunny has been involved in matches for just one year. He has had six bouts and won five of them. He said he learnt a great deal from the one defeat — training harder, the feeling of disappointment in myself, the feeling of loss — something I don't want to experience again. It made me want to dig deeper to prove to myself and others that I had more.

Sunny has said boxing has given him a lot that he never thought it would. "It's given me discipline. A lot of discipline. It's given me confidence. The days that I don't want to do things I still push through and do things. For example, I might feel like a sleep in but I get up to get the things done that need to get done. With my new confidence I feel like I can have a conversation with someone a lot easier than I was able to. I'm more confident in myself. The things that I have done now I would have never really tried in the past...but it slowly came."

## P&C Supporting Student Learning

Our P&C are a dedicated group of parents doing what they can to support students of our school. Apart from a range of services – canteen, pastoral care worker, uniform, and lockers, the P&C also raise funds to purchase items identified by the staff which would improve student learning outcomes and safety beyond what is possible by state funding. At the P&C meeting on 20/3/23, the P&C allocated \$28,927.30 to the purchase of items. 
